Robotics and Hybrid ORs have come online fast and are already regarded as the new standard of care—essential to attracting and retaining the best surgical talent and critical for surgical intervention in conditions like cancer, tumours, brain disorders, spinal injuries, scoliosis, and wounds to delicate organs. Now, surgeons and clinicians have the ability to see deeply into soft tissues and wounds with powerfully vivid imaging technology, allowing them to plan surgeries using digital and 3D modelling and to harness the emerging power of Artificial Intelligence to inform care in real-time.

Leading centres across the country are rapidly embracing these new technologies. With this campaign, we will do more than simply catch up. We will make a quantum leap and advance the evolution and reputation of our hospital as a national leader in surgical excellence.

ADDRESSING URGENT CHALLENGES.

Spinal Robotics and a Hybrid OR are cornerstone investments which address many immediate health care challenges in New Brunswick including: distance, waits, growing demand, aging population, and competition for talent.

Surgical wait times are lengthening at our hospital. Our goal is for 95% of surgeries to be performed within the ideal target timeframe. In FY2022/23, 62% could be done in the ideal timeframe, and that number dropped to 58% in FY2023/24.

Pressures facing health care are amplified in New Brunswick: we have a larger proportion of seniors than other provinces and the highest rates of chronic health issues in the country. A quarter of us are already over 65, and we face high rates of obesity, heart disease, smoking, and chronic diseases.

Precision Surgical Robotics and a Hybrid OR are catalytic projects aligned with Horizon's strategic priorities: providing equitable and timely access to services, reducing health inequities, and providing services within a coordinated system.

We are the largest Maritime province, with patients spread across both urban and rural areas. We serve a catchment area of 1 million, an increase of 200,000 people in just a few years, with a 15% growth in population annually. We've seen more population growth in the past two years than in the past 29.

A rising tide lifts all boats: the acquisition of a Hybrid OR and Spinal Robotics technology together will have impacts across the provincial health care system to reduce bottlenecks, decrease repeat visits and surgeries, and improve patient flow.

This investment in health care will offer vast improvements in our ability to treat cancers, tumours, brain disorders, spinal injuries, childhood scoliosis, wounds to delicate organs, as well as major and complex traumas.

WE ARE READY.

Our donors have already made foundational investments in minimally invasive surgical technologies, MRI imaging, the O-Arm, the da Vinci robot, and 3D printing: all allied technologies needed to pave the way for us to take this next step. We are now in a position to complete the transformation and achieve the highest national standards. We've come a long way, but this campaign is the tipping point that will take us over the top to a whole new health care future.
