

Workin' 2 Win Employee Lottery Overview

- The Workin' 2 Win Employee Lottery has been a key engagement program with the Saint John Regional Hospital Foundation since 2012, proudly sponsored by belairdirect.
- To enter the lottery, staff in health care Zone 2 register through a secure online registration portal.
- To play, \$5.00 is deducted each pay period (biweekly). Staff may cancel at any time.

2 ways to win!

- Bi-weekly draw: \$1,500 grand prize + treat cart to share with their colleagues
- Individual Educational Grants: Funding to support individual learning and career growth

Individual Educational Grants for Conferences, Workshops, Seminars, or Certifications

These individual learning opportunities allow you to step outside of your daily routine, connect with others in your field, and explore new ideas and perspectives. Other benefits include exploring the latest trends, research, and best practices in your field to improve your job performance.

Who can apply:

Employees of Horizon Health Network (HHN) or Service New Brunswick (SNB) within HHN's Zone 2 health care system who are actively enrolled in the Workin' 2 Win employee lottery.

Individual applications only; no group applications or applications submitted by/for others.

You must not already have an active Workin' 2 Win Educational Grant. Previous recipients may reapply only after their prior grant has been completed and formally closed.

Funding Details:

Up to \$5,000 per individual.

Eligible individual expenses include registration, tuition/certification fees, travel, and per-diem meals.

If approved, you can only be reimbursed for your own expenses. Reimbursement must be submitted using the Foundation's reimbursement form. Approved payments are processed within three weeks submission.

Requirements:

Approval from your HHN Clinical/Administrative Director or your SNB Supervisor is required. Applicant must use the provided Support Form to confirm approval. The Support Form is available for download on our website: https://sjrhfoundation.ca/education/.

An overview/budget for the educational opportunity, along with a short essay describing how it will benefit your career development.

If you are approved, a quote and photo for celebrating the award would be appreciated.

When to apply:

Current Application Deadline: December 11, 2025

How to apply:

Online applications only. All required information must be included at the time of submission. Applications that are missing required information, have documents sent separately, or do not use the required Support

Form will not be accepted.

Selection Process: Applications will be reviewed by the Saint John Regional Hospital Foundation, which reserves the sole right to evaluate and select grantees from the eligible applicant pool. Meeting the eligibility and submission requirements does not guarantee funding.

All awards must be utilized within 24 months of the award date.
